



# Head Start Application

A Family Focused, No Cost Preschool

## Complete and return the application with the following information

- All income received in 2021, for all parents or guardians who live in the household.
  - W-2, income tax return, child support, disability, unemployment, SSI, TANF, SNAP school grants, or self-employment.
- Child's Immunization Record
  - Include a copy of child's lead/iron test
- Child's Birth Certificate
  - Hospital certificate, passport, state or military ID, or custody/court orders are acceptable
- Custody, protection, or other court orders regarding your child
- Insurance Card
- Foster Care Status

Children must be three years old to be enrolled in Head Start, but an application can be completed before their third birthday. Children may attend Head Start until they go to Kindergarten.

Income eligibility is based on the Federal Poverty Guidelines, however all applicants will be considered. Age, income, disability of the child, and family situations are used to prioritize applications.
