



Head Start Application

A Family Focused, No Cost Preschool

Complete and return the application with the following information

- All income received in 2023, for all parents or guardians who live in the household.
W-2, income tax return, child support, disability, unemployment, SSI, TANF, SNAP, school grants, or self-employment income
- Child's Immunization Record
- Child's Birth Certificate
- Custody, protection, or other court orders regarding the child
- Insurance Card
- Foster Care Status

Applications can be completed before the child's third birthday, but the child must be three years old to enroll in Head Start. Children may attend Head Start until they go to kindergarten.

Income eligibility is based on the Federal Poverty Guidelines, however all applicants will be considered. Age, income, IDEA Status, and family situations are used to prioritize applications.
